WHEREAS, the Authority has received bills and claims for the services provided; and


WHEREAS, the Authority has funds on hand to pay the said bills and claims; and

**Resolution No.: 2015-026**


**WHEREAS**, the passage of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) affected the employee health benefit requirements for employees; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to incorporate the requirements of the ACA, the Commissioners desire to adjust the salaries of all part-time employees, in conjunction with the adjustment of their hours,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners of the Union City Parking Authority, that the salaries of all part-time employees are increased to accommodate the requirements of the ACA, that part-time employees work 29 hours per week, retroactive to the date the 29 hour work week went into effect for the part-time parking enforcement officers.


**WHEREAS**, the Union City Parking Authority desires to purchase and install camera equipment in the parking deck and has therefore obtained three written quotes for said service and materials; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners of the Union City Parking Authority, that the Executive Director of the Union City Parking Authority, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement, as approved by the attorney for the Parking Authority, with Union Alarmtronic LLC, in accordance with its quote, subject to availability of funds, in a sum not to exceed \$17,470.00, for the installation of cameras, including services and materials.


